**Investing in a Strong Provincial Trauma
System: The Value Proposition**

Dr. Evans is a Trauma and Acute Care General Surgeon currently practicing at the Vancouver General Hospital, Vancouver, British Columbia. He completed a B.A. at Princeton University (1984), an MD (1988) and General Surgery Residency Training (1993) at McGill University, Critical Care Training at the University of Toronto (1997), and a M.Sc. (Epidemiology) at UBC (2010). He was Trauma Director at the Montreal General Hospital, McGill University Health Centre from 1997-2005, following which he joined UBC and the VGH Department of Surgery in 2005. He has since served as both VGH site Trauma Director and Vancouver Coastal Health Regional Trauma Director. From 2013-2021, he served as Provincial Medical Director, Trauma Services B.C. (TSBC) where he has helped lead consolidation of the B.C. trauma system through broad partner engagement around a strong vision of an integrated provincial system of injury control and trauma management. He has been an active contributor to the Trauma Association of Canada for over 20 years and supports the Trauma Distinction Program of Accreditation Canada. He supports TSBC research and analytics with an interest in trauma system design and operation.
